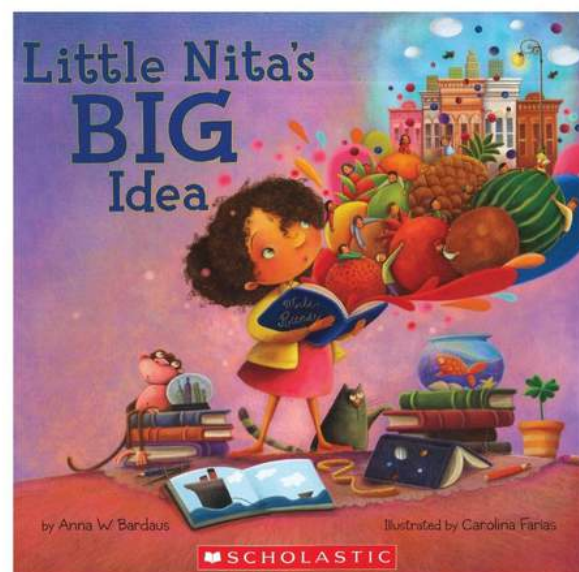

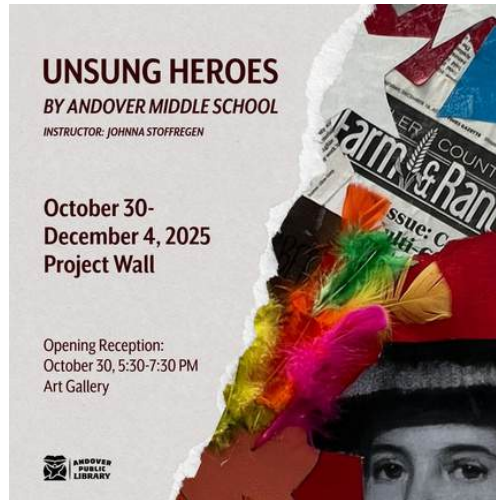

A cofounder of the Warclan Collective, Rutledge invites viewers to witness stories of resilience and renewal, bringing ancestral voices into vivid dialogue with the present.
