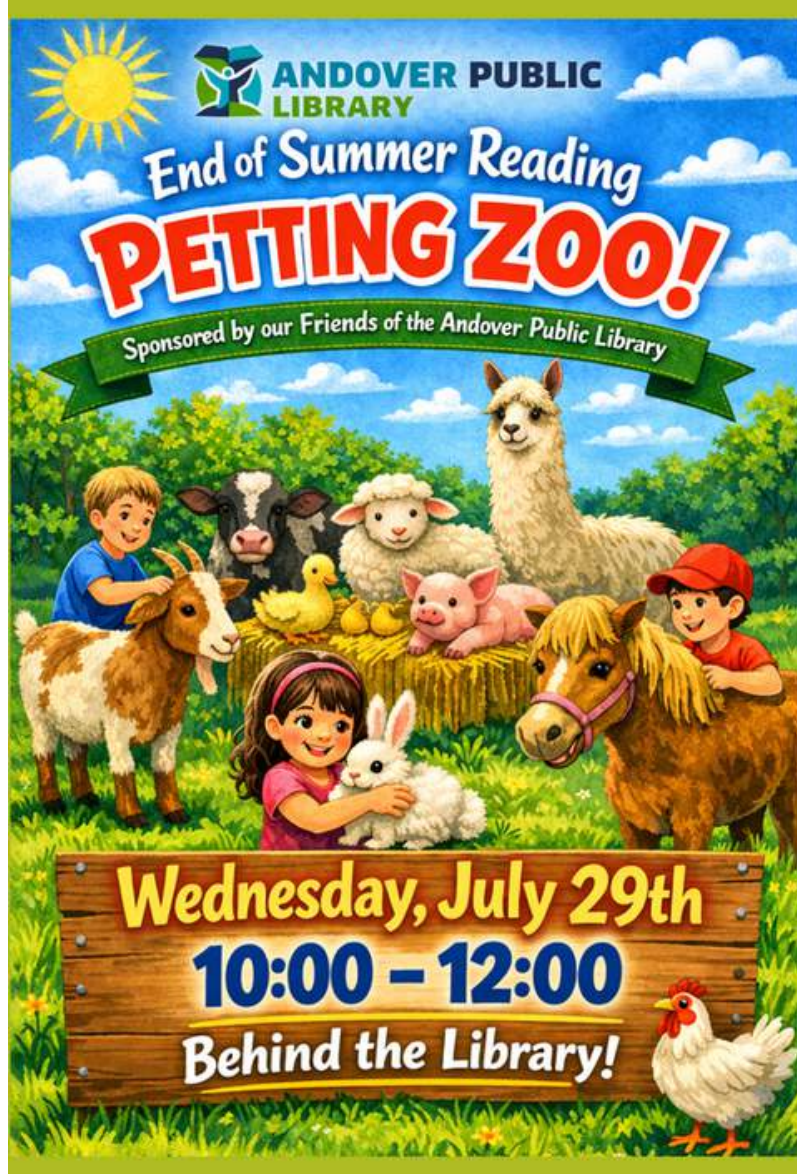

Faculty Art Show

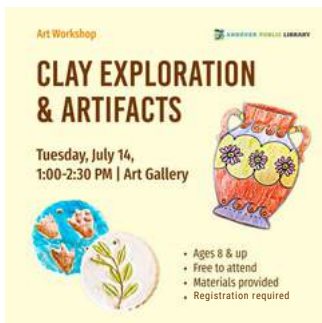

Art Workshop: Clay Exploration & Artifacts Tuesday, July 14, 1:00-2:30 PM

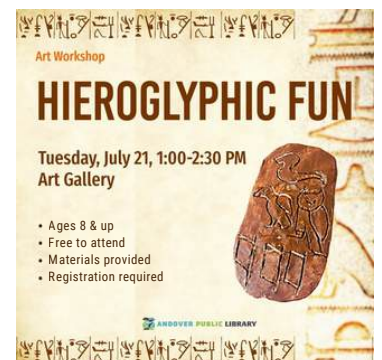
